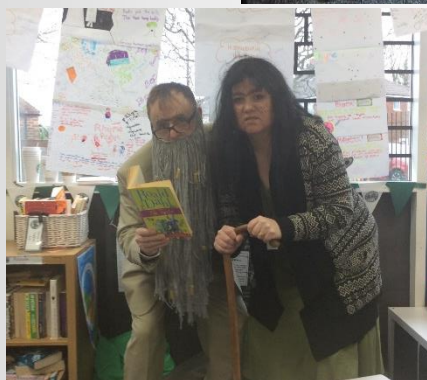
Mad Hatter's Day & Comic Relief
