Do you have what it takes to get on the FGA TTRS Leader board?

Having a secure knowledge of the times tables is vitally important for the children, as it helps them to work efficiently when calculating in all areas of maths. Children are expected to be secure in the 2, 5 and 10 x tables by the end of year 2, and in all tables up to the 12 x tables by the end of year 4. TTRS logins can be found in your child's planner. Once logged in children can participate in times table battles such as Battle of the Bands, Arena and Rock Slam, in which they will play against other classes/children in school to try and earn rewards through their knowledge of the times tables.

Year 3

Year 3 have been beach explorers in their English lessons.
