Welcome back to Nursery Class!


The children will continue to be taught by Miss Rothwell, Miss Stout and Mrs Noor. School starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3.05pm. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time each day and tell us or telephone if you would like someone else to collect your child. We can only allow your child to leave with another adult if you have given your permission.

Uniform reminder—All children should be wearing full school uniform (Red gingham summer dresses may be worn) and school shoes. Long hair should be tied back with a plain bobble and no earrings should be worn



Themes

This half term we will become explorers and historians as we explore our topic 'The Seaside'. We will journey both across and under the sea. I wonder what our favourite mode of transport will be? We will also be exploring what the seaside is like now and how it was in the past. We will have to be on our guard as there may be Pirates about but we are very excited to hunt for treasure and make treasure maps. We are also excited to release our butterflies which we have looked after in class whilst we have continued to explore minibeasts and lifecycles. In science we will be exploring forces



using a range of equipment including magnets and springs. The children will continue to learn and explore these topics through the six learning areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage. These are split into 3 prime areas; Physical Development, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Communication and Language. There are also 4 prime areas; Mathematics, Literacy, Expressive Arts and Design and Knowledge and Understanding of the World. We will also continually support your children to develop their core and fine motor skills alongside their mark-making and encouraging independence in regards to self-care.

Library Books:

The children will be given a new library book each Tuesday to be returned the following Monday. Try to read the book regularly to

your child throughout the week and make a note in their reading diary. Encourage your child to turn the pages and discuss the pictures and predict what they think might happen next. This broadens their vocabulary and develops their understanding of story structures alongside helping to develop their listening and attention skills.
