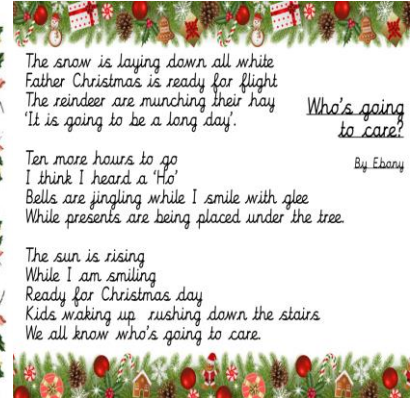
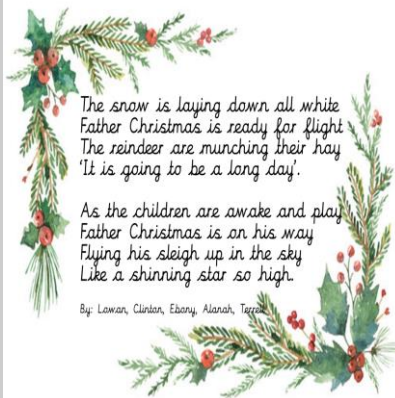
## Year 3
