On the weekend of the 6th- 8th May we celebrate the Coronation of King Charles. This historic event will be televised around the world. The Coronation of His Majesty The King and Her Majesty The Queen Consort is a time for celebration across the nation and the Commonwealth and it will take place over a weekend of special events. On Saturday 6th May the Coronation Ceremony takes place at Westminster Abbey, London. The 6th – 8th May will see [Coronation Big Lunches](#) up and down the country and across the Commonwealth. A spectacular Coronation Concert will be performed at Windsor Castle with iconic locations across the UK lit up using projections, lasers, drone displays and illuminations. This will take place on Sunday 7th May.
