Results will be shared with parents once they've been received in mid-July. Well done to all the children involved for all their hard work preparing to reach the 'expected' standard and above. Y6 will now be focusing on writing and gathering evidence to secure the right level of achievement.

Next week, we turn our attention to Y2. Children will start their Y2 SATs assessments which judge the level of ability of each child as they prepare to leave KS1 (infants) and enter KS2 (juniors). After the Y2 SATs are concluded, Y1 will complete their phonics screening checks. These take place in June.
