Year 4 had a fantastic day on Wednesday, as part of our Maya day we had a visit from an archaeologist! She brought some amazing replicas of Maya artefacts, which the children were able to hold and use clues to find out what they were. As well as a scale model of an ancient Maya house, sculptures and artwork of Maya gods and traditional grinding stones used to grind corn to make tortillas. We also tried on traditional clothing worn by the Maya, including some headdresses, skirts and even traditional underpants! In the afternoon we explored some poo samples, using tweezers, lollipop sticks and magnifying glasses to dissect each sample and decide whether it was Viking, Maya or modern poo. Finally, we had the opportunity to examine real fragments from Maya pottery which were thousands of years old and use clues to decide what type of vessel they were once part of. What an incredible day to get us excited about our new history topic!
