Huge congratulations to the Y4 staff and pupils for all the hard work and effort they have undertaken this year to learn their multiplication tables. The children have recently completed their national multiplication checks, which assesses the children's ability to respond to 25 timed multiplication questions. Our Year 4 children performed brilliantly and 64% achieved a score of 20 or more out of 25, with 48% of pupils achieving full marks! Well done Year 4! Fantastic results.

Further congratulations to our Year 1 team who have worked relentlessly with the children to support their phonic development, enabling them to become readers! The children have now completed their national phonics screening checks and 83% of pupils met the expected standard. This is a fantastic achievement and progress has been very strong this year. All children have made very good progress and this places them in an excellent position as they get ready to enter Year 2. Well done to all those involved in teaching phonics groups and to the children for working so hard to achieve these results. Well done Year 1!

Thank you to all our families for joining us this week for sports day. It was lovely to see the events so well attended.
