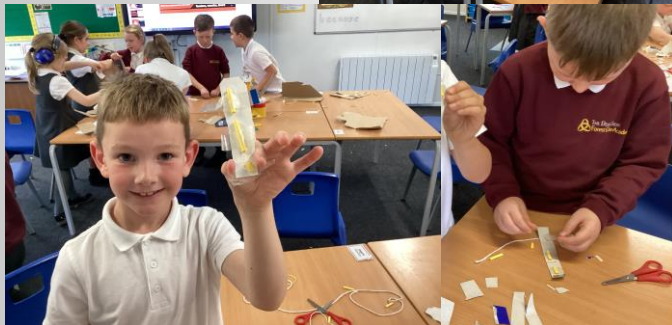
Week 2 of Art Club
