Tapestry Parent Introduction 2023



- Tapestry is an online learning journal system (its our home-school sharing platform in the EYFS).
- ► There is an app and browser version available
- We use it to record children's key learning and development using tablet devices and it helps to inform our assessments.
- You are set up as parents/carers with your own secure logins so you can view, comment on and add your own observations about your child.



- It creates a two way communication between us (the staff), and you (the parents/guardians/carers)
- We will upload media, meaning you can see pictures and videos of what your child is really up to whilst they are with us
- There are greater opportunities to extend your child's learning at home – you can view next steps, add your own observations and communicate with us whenever you like
- Unlike a physical, hard copy book, it's easy to share with groups of relatives, such as extended families, separated parents and relatives living overseas



- As an academy we use Tapestry as one of several ways to inform our assessments.
- ► We observe and record key moments in your child's development.
- ▶ This is a quick outline of how we do this for your information:
- 1. We write a record of what we saw your child do.
- 2. We try to quote the child accurately using the exact language that he/she used.
- 3. Sometimes we also note the progress or comment on the learning demonstrated.
- 4. Sometimes we will write next steps so you know what to focus on with your child at home.

How is the data kept safe?



- A password is required to access Tapestry, remember the stronger the password you set, the more secure your account is
- You are linked manually to your child/children so you can only view observations for them


Logging in

- An initial login link to Tapestry has been sent to your email address.
- You need to click this link to activate your account where you will create your own password.
- You can reset your password by email if you forget it)
- For future times you will need to go to this URL to log in: <u>https://tapestryjournal.com/</u> Alternatively you can search for Tapestry through Google or download and login via the tapestry app.





Once you have successfully logged in you will be taken to the home page. Here you will be able to see your child's observations in chronological order. It is likely that the first time you log in there won't be very many, but this list will grow throughout your child's time at their settina.





Observations

- An observation may have a photo(s)/videos/audio files attached. Underneath the media you will see the notes, so the actual observation. Often we may add a next step which help guide how to support your child's learning at home.
- You are also be able to add comments the observation.
- You will not receive daily observations. We use Tapestry to record key wow learning moments for your child and encourage you to share the same about them from home.
- Sharing observations with us also helps us get to know your children and celebrate in their successes.



Adding your own Observations

There will be times when you want to add observations to Tapestry. These can then be seen by your child's key person at their Setting and used to make assessments, or just as a contribution to the journal. In order to add an observation, you first need to click on the blue 'Add Observation' button. This can be found on the home 'Observations' tab





Adding your own Observations

Once you have clicked on it, you will be taken to the page shown below. Here you will need to pick your child/children from the drop down list, add a title, and then you can add some notes and media. Don't forget to press 'Save' at the end
