This half term we are writing to entertain through a descriptive piece of writing. We will look at the features of these types of texts and incorporate different elements of SPaG. We will be using

'The Eye of the Wolf' by Daniel Pennac as inspiration for our work.



In Maths we will be focusing on place value. This underpins all areas of maths and is an essential building block to support children throughout the year. The children will

continuously be develop in confidence answering reasoning and problem solving questions which are embedded into every lesson.

In Science we will be immersing ourselves in the topic 'Animals including humans'. Exploring and explaining the human muscular and skeleton system and discussing the importance of a nutritious, balanced diet.

In Geography, our topic is 'Rivers'. We will be learning the course of a river and examining the importance of water as a commodity to humans and travel.

This half term in History we are researching the Stone Age to Iron Age period. We will be exploring what they ate, how they lived and looking at key sites Skara Brae and

Stonehenge.
