This term in Year 5 we are starting the term using the book 'Cosmic' by Frank Cottrell Boyce. The children will be given the opportunity to explore the book in Guided Reading. There will be a focus on new vocab, and retrieving information from the text. The children will also use this book as a stimulus for their first piece of writing. The children will be taught a variety of sentence types and build these to form an adventure story. We cannot wait to see the fantastic stories that we hope they will produce.



In Maths we will be focusing on place value. This is an essential topic to ensure that the children can then further explore mathematics throughout the year. We will be continuing to explore maths through mastery techniques encouraging the children to express their understanding, reasoning and problem solving. The children will be given the opportunity to understand where Maths fits with everyday life.



This term we will be focusing on our Geography topic, 'Europe and the Wider World'. The children will learn all about the countries in Europe, studying the physical and human characteristics of a variety of nations. They will then explore how this fits into the wider world.





Our Science topic this half term is Space. Children love to learn about Space and it is an exciting topic to research. The children will learn about spherical bodies, the planets, night and cay, theories about space and the movement of the moon. As part of their homework this half term the children will be asked to create models or posters to display in the classroom.
