
#### Year 4

As part of our science topic Animals Including Humans, Year 4 carried out an investigation into how different liquids affect the enamel on our teeth. We used egg shells to represent the hard outer layer of enamel on our teeth and placed each egg shell in cola, coffee, orange juice and water. To make sure it was a fair test, the children measured each liquid using a plastic beaker. Which liquid do you think will change the egg shells the most?



#### Year 5

This week the Year 5 pupils were investigating the phases of the moon. They were challenged with replicating the phases using Oreo cookies. This led to lots of questions and observations about the moon. Pupils were able to scientifically record their observations and have been asked to observe the changes in the moon's appearance over the next month.
