Hello and welcome back to a new term in Reception Class!

The children will continue to be taught by Miss Hicks, Miss Taylor, Miss Stout and Miss Richardson.

Doors open at 8.35, school starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3.15 pm.

Please ensure your child arrives at school on time each day and tell us or telephone if you would like someone else to collect your child. We can only allow your child to leave with another adult if you have given your permission.



Themes

This half term our learning will be focused around the themes of keeping healthy, Africa, space and Chinese New Year. In PSED we will be learning about healthy eating, dental health and exercise. In UW we will be learning about life in Africa, space travel and Chinese New Year. Our key fiction texts are 'Handa's Surprise' 'The Way Back Home' and 'The Great Race.' Our key non-fiction books are 'Lét's Explore Kenya', and 'I am Neil Armstrong' alongside various information books about space and Chinese New Year.

Mathematics

The children will continue to explore the composition



of numbers within 10, combining groups and measuring capacity, weight, length and time.

Library Books

The children will be given a new library book each Monday. Try to read the book regularly to your child throughout the week. This broadens their vocabulary and develops their understanding of story structures.

Reading Books The children are progressing well with their phonic skills and most children now have reading books. This half term they will be given some new tricky words to learn at home. It is very important that you support your child in their learning by working with them at home as often as possible on their phonics, letter formation, tricky words and reading books. If you have any concerns or questions please ask us at any time.
