We continue to try and maintain high levels of good attendance and improve absence rates. This time of year it can be challenging with lots of winter bugs circulating around. However, recently the NHS has launched the Pharmacy First scheme. This means that you can now get treatment for 7 common conditions directly from your local pharmacy instead of waiting for a GP appointment. Pharmacists can now supply prescription medicines, including antibiotics and antivirals where appropriate, to treat 7 common health conditions. The 7 common conditions are: sinusitis, a sore throat, earache, infected insect bites, impetigo, shingles and urinary tract infections. This hopefully means that you and your children can receive the appropriate medication faster. If you need medication administering throughout the school day, please see the admin team and complete the relevant form.

We hope you all have a lovely half term break and we look forward to welcoming you back on **MONDAY 19TH FEBRUARY**.

As usual she was fantastic.

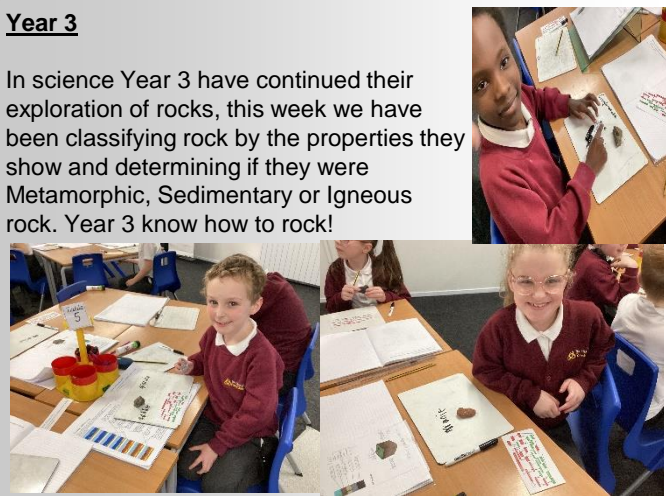
