Headteacher Comment

Over the course of the previous months we have had a number of applications for holidays. Please remember that holidays in term time <u>are not</u> permitted by the school and it will result in a Local Authority penalty notice currently at the cost of £60 per child, per parent. This doubles in cost if it is not paid in the first 21 days. If your child is out of school for a holiday the first step is to complete a holiday request form. You may then be required to attend a meeting in school. If the holiday is taken then the local authority will send a penalty notice once the holiday has been completed. Please note that these can take months to come through. Children who miss work in that time will not have the opportunity to cover this when they return and this can impact heavily on their subsequent learning and achievement. Please ensure your child is in school every day.
